RMUTSV's Emblem



The Emblem of Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya (RMUTSV) represents the Royal Foundation which RMUTSV is built upon. It is a circular logo under the Great Crown of Victory (Pramahapichaimongkut). Inside the circle are 8 lotus petals representing the Noble Eightfold Path (Magga 8) and the spirit of light. Encompassed by the lotus petals is the Royal Emblem depicts the Privy Seal of the Ninth Reign (Prarajcharunjakorn) or the symbol of the King Bhumibol Adulyadaj who graciously conferred the university's name. Further out of the emblem, at both sides of the end of a strip, there are supernatural flowers that represent civility, cheer and pleasantness. The refined Emblem of Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya (RMUTSV) is appreciated by all. It also symbolizes the deep concern Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya (RMUTSV) with developing vocational education and expanding the fields as the Royal vision.

A Brief History



On January 8, 2005 in the 9th day of 2 lunar month, His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej (Ninth reign) signed the “Rajamangala University of Technology Act,”. The law, announced in the Royal Gazette ten days later before coming into effect on January 18, 2005, combines all nine Rajamangala University of Technology (RMUT) located all over Thailand; namely, RMUT Thanyaburi, RMUT Krungthep, RMUT Tawan-ok, RMUT Phra Nakhon, RMUT Rattanakosin, RMUT Lanna, RMUT Isarn, RMUT Suvarnabhumi and RMUT Srivijaya.

The main aim of decentralization to all regions in Thailand is to foster independence and flexibility so they handle their own affairs under the university council. Apart from this, another intention is to turn these nine universities into science and technology universities offering

advanced vocational training in undergraduate, graduate and Ph.D. levels to facilitate vocational students and to provide educational opportunities to those who graduated from community colleges. All nine RMUT have been under the supervision of the Office of Commission on Higher Education (OCHE), Ministry of Education.

Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya, (RMUTSV), is one of the universities in the group of Rajamangala University of Technology (RMUT). RMUTSV is located in the south of Thailand. The university is made up of three provincial areas including five campuses namely; Songklha Campus, Nakhon Si Thammarat (Thung Yai) Campus, Nakhon Si Thammarat (Sai Yai) Campus, Nakhon Si Thammarat (Khanom)

Campus, and Trang Campus. RMUTSV offers education at the high vocational and graduate level in eleven faculties, three colleges, two institutes, one research center, and one Aquarium museum such as the faculties of Business Administration, Agriculture, Liberal Arts, Management Technology Science and Technology, Agro-industry, Engineering, Architecture, Science and Fisheries, Technology Veterinary Medicine, College of Industrial Technology and Management and Rattaphum College, College of Hospitality and Tourism, and Rajamangala Aquarium Trang. Currently RMUTSV has more than 16,000 students. There are about 4,000-5,000 enrollments each year.



About the University



Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya (abbreviated as RMUTSV) pays great attention to the management of higher education, particularly in the fields of science and technology as well as services. The main aim is to produce graduates who have both the professional ability to manage a career and are highly aware of the practical ethics in society and the nation. Additionally, a policy we focus on is to concentrate the development of teaching and learning, research, community service, cultural preservation and environment sustainability as well as staff development to keep pace with globalization so as to complete the vision of the university.

►► University's symbolic tree: Yang/Yang-na Tree

Yang or Yang na is the royal charity tree which has bole tall, straight and its fruit has 2-3 wings. When the fruit scatters from the tree, it is elegantly blown by the wind. These characteristics are as if using proficient knowledge with mindfulness to serve society and continuously develop oneself. It is like the movement of Yang-na's fruit when blown by wind.

▶▶ RMUTSV's Mascot



No Ra Kinnaree is the mascot of Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya with the combination of No Ra and Kinnaree. No Ra or Manora is a southern traditional dance and Kinnaree is a mythical half-human half-bird creature. No Ra Kinnaree wears a headdress (part of the Manora costume) and its body is a Kinnaree. This represents the harmony and unity of Thai people.

▶▶ RMUTSV's Sculpture



The RMUTSV Sculpture Design represents the university's official emblem which is composed of the Privy Seal of the ninth reign (Phra Rajalunjakorn), the symbolic Letter "Unalome" insignia as well as the Great Crown of Victory (Phra Maha Pichai Crown). The sculpture design was influenced by Srivijaya Arts, which typically appears on the image of Phra Bodhisattva. Being straight and upright of Phra Bodhisattva means

stability and strength whilst the gentle curves of the eight lotus petals symbolize not only the beauty and flexibility of the Fine Arts but also the wisdom in the Buddhism Philosophy. The symbolic Letter "Unalome" insignia looks like the Thai numeral 9 meaning the ninth reign of Rattanakosin Dynasty of Thailand. All of the symbols presented on the sculpture signify the prosperity of Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya.

Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya, Rattaphum College is located at 414 M.14 Phetkasem Road, Tha Chamuang, Rattaphum, Songkhla, 90180, Thailand. Formerly, it was known as the Rajamangala Institute of Technology, Southern Campus. After the law governing the institution was changed, it was transformed into a university. At present, the university offers vocational diploma and bachelor's degree in the following majors:

Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya, Trang Campus is located at 179 M.3 Mai Fad, Sikao, Trang 92150, Thailand. The university has continuously developed teaching methodology and curriculum suitable for the needs of learners and also supports lecturers' work, innovations, throughout community services.

The university consists of 1 faculty and 1 college. The university offers both 4-year bachelor degrees and transfer programs as follows:

1. Faculty of Science and Fisheries Technology is composed of Aquaculture, Food Industry, Information Technology, Electronic Engineering, Environmental Science, Local Environmental Management, Chemical Industry, Fisheries and Aquaculture Business Management, Industrial Technology, and Marine Science programs. Additionally, the faculty also provides a master degree in the field of Science: Environmental Management Technology, Aquaculture Technology, and Integrated Coastal Management.



2. College of Hospitality and Tourism is composed of 4 programs: Hospitality and Tourism, Hotel, English for International Communication, and Accounting.

The university also offers Rajamangala Trang Aquarium with displays of freshwater fish and saltwater fish, Seashell Museum, dugong and whale shark skeletons, as well as dugong carcasses exhibition. Another thing to impress visitors is the show of dugongs. It happens twice in a normal day, 10.30 a.m., and 14.30 p.m. and 4 times on official holidays, 10.30 a.m., 11.30 a.m., 14.30 p.m., and 15.30 p.m.



The Rajamangala Walkway or Mangrove Forest Trail is also one of RMUTSV's projects established to create an aquatic nursery and educational and research hub highlighting the delicate but essential mangrove eco-system. It is suitable for students, academics, particularly those who are passionate about nature to study and admire its beauty. In fact, the trail consists of 4 trails but 2 are under construction.



Apart from this, the college of hospitality and tourism provides luxury resort with various kinds of rooms and traditional massage which has various types such as reflexology (foot massage) and the royal Thai massage done by the students. It is open daily at the Tourist Service Center, Rajamangala Beach, Trang.

All these efforts reflect that Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya Trang Campus not only focuses on academia but also provides real experience for the students to expose them to problems in real situations. This reaches the university's goal of "practicing graduates".

Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya Nakhon Si Thammarat, Sai Yai Campus was established on December, 23 1935 under the act of secondary agricultural school of Thung Song district. Over the decades, the university has been continuously developing until now, being one of the most professional universities in the field of teaching Agriculture in southern Thailand. Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya Nakhon Si Thammarat (Sai Yai) is located at 109 Thungsong-Nakornsi, M.2, Thumyai, Thung Song, Nakorn Si Thammarat. The faculties provided are:

Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya Nakhon Si Thammarat, Thung Yai Campus is located at 133 M. 5, Thung Yai, Thung Yai, Nakorn Si Thammarat. Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya College of Industrial Technology and Management Nakhon Si Thammarat, Khanom Campus



Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya College of Industrial Technology and Management Nakhon Si Thammarat, Khanom Campus is located at 99 M. 4, Thong Nian, Khanom, Nakorn Si Thammarat. Originally, it was renamed Srivijaya campus being subjected to Rajamangala Technology Institution. It was established on September, 26, 1995 according to the announcement of the Ministry of Education. In 2005, Rajamangala Technology Institution announced the Rajamangala University of Technology Act. Thus, Srivijaya campus was later changed to be Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya College of Industrial Technology and Management Nakhon Si Thammarat Campus (Khanom) or College of Industrial Technology and Management, for short.

The university is surrounded by beautiful natural resources and ancient remains such as Jeedepakarung (coral pagoda), Prathap Cape, and the Footsteps of Luang Pu Thuat the Holy Trail which is open to visitors.

Rajamangala Srivijaya Center of Research and Training, Chumporn



Rajamangala Srivijaya Center of Research and Training, Chumporn has established with the aim to help the victims of "Typhoon Gay" which hit the Thai gulf on November, 4 1989 causing loss of life and property. Rajamangala Technology Institution or Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya (at present) responded to the disaster by forming the Flowers and Fruits Reproduction Center to assist the victims.

The center has built in an area of 218 rai located at 168 M. 5, Thale Sap, Pathio, Chumporn. In the past, it was subjected to the Special Task Division and later in 1996 it changed its name to the Student Research and Training Center, Chumporn.

In 2005, it was included in the Rajamangala University Act and the name was changed again to Rajamangala Srivijaya Center of Research and Training, Chumporn The major roles are to focus on education and research to serve and support the university's missions. This center is now under the supervision of the Faculty of Agriculture, Nakorn Si Thammarat.
